ROPA METHOD

The Treatment

The ROPA method is aimed at female couples who wish to share motherhood together and actively participate in the reproductive process, either by their own choice and/or for medical reasons of one member of the couple.

It is an In Vitro Fertilisation (IVF) cycle where the oocytes of one of the women is implanted in the uterus of the other female partner. This allows both women to actively participate in the process, with the aim of achieving a full-term pregnancy and, consequently, a healthy newborn at home.



How we start

Phases of the ROPA treatment



Ovarian Stimulation

The female partner who is going to provide her eggs begins ovarian stimulation, which consists of self-administering daily injections. Naturally, the woman produces only one egg each month, but thanks to this hormonal treatment, which lasts between 10 and 20 days, several eggs are developed. This allows us to obtain several eggs, which can be used over several cycles, without the need to repeat the process.



Once the eggs have reached the right number and size, a dose of hCG hormone is administered to induce their maturation and, 36 hours later, the collection is scheduled.



In Vitro Fertilisation

Once the eggs have been collected, they are fertilised in vitro using donor sperm. There are two methods for this. One method consists of injecting one sperm into each of the eggs, a method known as ICSI. The other involves placing the eggs and the sperm sample in a culture dish to enable the fertilisation to occur naturally.



Once the eggs are fertilised, and they become embryos they are cultured in the laboratory for 3 to 5 days. During this time our embryologists monitor their development to classify them according to their morphology and ability to divide, in order to determine which is the best embryo.



Endometrial preparation

The innermost layer of the uterus, where the embryo implants, is called the endometrium. The woman who is going to receive the embryo needs to undergo endometrial preparation. This consists of the administration of a hormonal treatment with oestrogen and progesterone to achieve a correct endometrial thickness, thus maximising the chances of embryo implantation and, with that, of pregnancy.



Transferring the best embryo

Once the pregnant woman's uterus is receptive, the best embryo is transferred into the uterine cavity using a cannula. This is a quick and painless process that does not require anaesthesia or aftercare, so patients can return home soon after.

Treatment Cost
